


General Information to Participants

- Cochin International Airport to RSET : 28 Km (Approx.)
- Aluva Railway Station to RSET : 18 Km (Approx.)
- Ernakulam Junction Railway Station (a.k.a.Ernakulam South) to RSET : 13 Km (Approx.)
- Ernakulam Town Railway Station (a.k.a Ernakulam North) to RSET : 12 Km (Approx.)


Reaching Rajagiri School of Engineering & Technology from Nearby Places

From Aluva Railway Station



- All KSRTC buses (From KSRTC Bus Stand, which is near to Aluva Railway Station) to **Trippunithura** through “**Airport – Seaport Road**” drop you at the **Rajagiri Bus Stop**. Then use auto rickshaws that will take you to the college 1 km's from the Bus Stop.

From Ernakulam South (near to Ernakulam Junction Railway Station), Ernakulam North (near to Ernakulam Town Railway Station)



- All buses to **Kakkanad** drop you at the **Civil Station Bus Stop**. Then use auto rickshaws that will take you to the college 3 km's from the Bus Stop.

Climate in Kochi

- Temperatures range between 20 degrees Celsius and 35 degrees Celsius.
- Do make sure you carry an umbrella or raincoat.

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Some tourist attractions in Kochi

- Marine Drive is a picturesque promenade in Kochi. It is built facing the backwaters, and is a popular hangout for the local populace.
- Fort Kochi – Famous for cantilevered Chinese fishing nets.
- Hill Palace is the largest archaeological museum in Kerala, near Tripunithura. It was the administrative office of Kochi Rajas.
- Mattancherry Palace, also known as the Dutch Palace, in Mattancherry, Kochi
- Jewish Synagogue, or the Paradesi Synagogue, is the oldest synagogue in the Commonwealth of Nations.
- Santa Cruz Cathedral Basilica, a church built originally by the Portuguese and elevated to a Cathedral by Pope Paul IV in 1558.
- Kochi International Marina: Kochi is an excellent stop for yachts, and the marina is placed ideally within the city, attached to the shoreline of the historic Bolgatty Palace Hotel in Bolgatty Island.
- Willingdon Island is a man-made island named after Lord Willingdon, a former British Viceroy to India.
- Museum of Kerala History, Edappally: Important scenes of Kerala history are portrayed through sculptures.
- St. Francis Church, originally built in 1503, is the oldest European church in India.

Around Kochi

- Athirappilly Falls (Film Shooting Location – Guru, Bahubali etc) is in the neighboring Thrissur district and is around 60 km from Kochi.
- Alappuzha Backwaters (Famous for House Boats) is around 70 km from Kochi.
- Cherai Beach is a beach is just 30 km from Kochi.

- Kalady is a popular pilgrim center because it is the birthplace of Sri Adi Sankara, one of India's foremost philosopher-saints who preached the Advaita or monastic philosophy.
- Bhoothathankettu is a dam and tourist site. It is situated in the village of Pindimana, about 50 km from the Kochi.
- Paliyam Palace, Chendamangalam is about 42 km from Kochi.
- Munnar (Famous for Tea Gardens), 120 km from Kochi.
